Assault Bill for Sanitarians signed into law

Letters from Local 768 President Fitz Reid and DC 37 Exec. Director Henry Garrido, along with dedicated member action on Lobby Day, paid off when NYS Governor Andrew Cuomo signed into law a bill that makes it a D Felony to assault a Public Health Sanitarian who is on duty. With this stroke of a pen, these members join Local 768 Social Workers who are also protected by the same law.

While assaults are generally prosecuted depending on their severity, having this law on the books sets the foundation for a DOHMH campaign advising the public that our members enjoy extra protection under the law, making them safer at work.
